“Stepping into the River”

Joshua 3:1-17

Big Idea: God will almost always ensure that an obstacle is in your way which will require you to step out in faith to receive His best outcome.

How do we step into our own journeys by faith?

1. When you see God moving, move in the same direction. (3)

2. Before you go, consecrate yourself. (5)

“Consecrate” means:

- Set yourself aside for a holy purpose.
- Allow God to purify you and make you holy.
- Allow God to make you a powerful holy force in the kingdom.

3. Make sure you allow God to go before you. (6)

First, ensure that God is in front of you.

Second, keep a holy respect of the presence and leadership of God.

Lessons:

- Don’t get ahead of God! Let Him lead.
- Have a holy reverence for His presence in your life.
- Keep your eye on Him, not the circumstances.

4. Step out in total faith. (8)

5. Recognize that God’s timing is often not the same as yours. (16)

God provides miracles two ways:

- There are times it is immediate and obvious to all.
- There are other times when we step out in faith...and wait.
