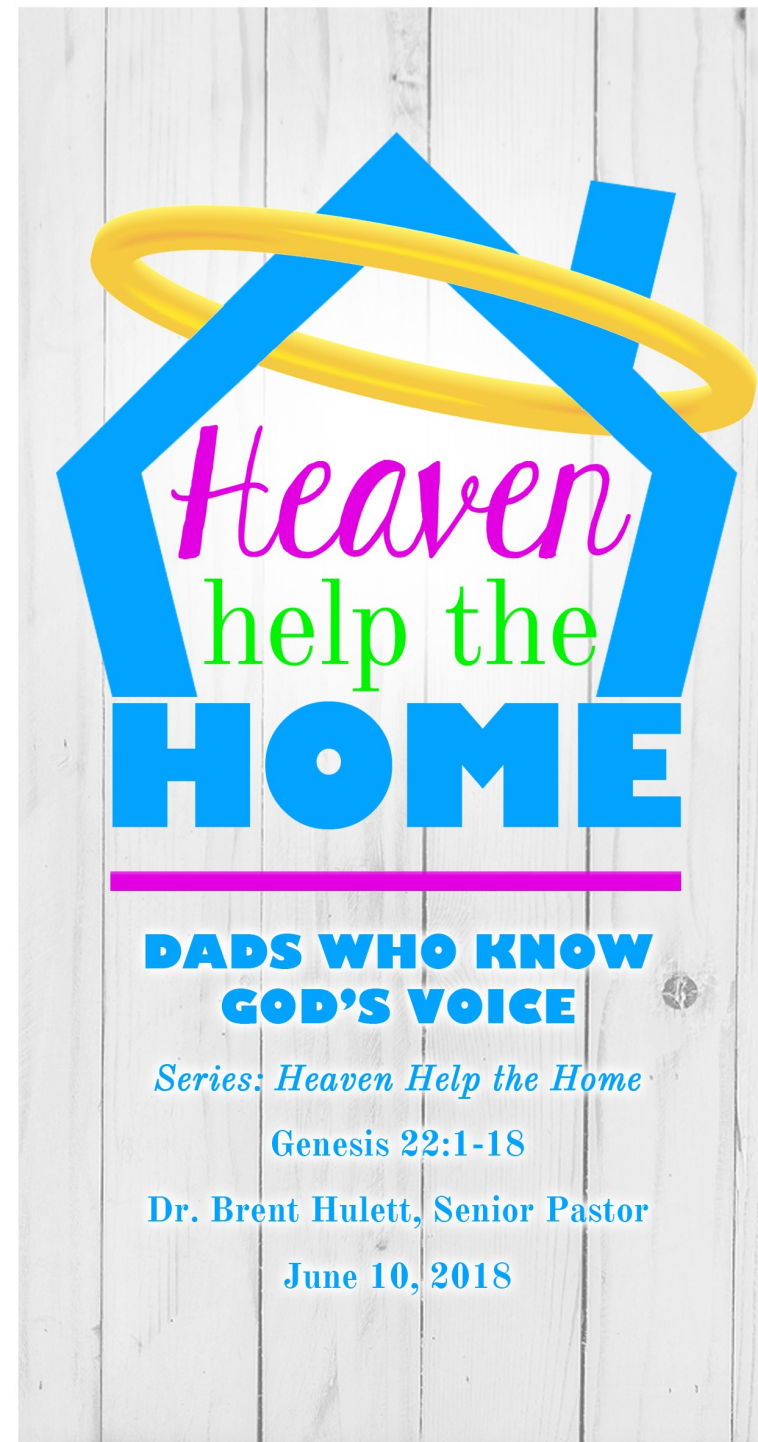

Series: Heaven Help the Home

Genesis 22:1-18

BIG IDEA: Abraham shows how dads and grandpas are to lead with great faith and readiness in order for their children to follow God.

If there is no father in the home:

- 4 times greater risk of poverty
- 7 times more likely to become pregnant as teen
- 2 times more likely to drop out of high-school
- 279% higher chance for children to carry guns and deal drugs than peers living with their fathers.
- 90% of felons grew up without a father.

Recent Study Concerning Dads and Church Attendance:

- If the father is *irregular* in church attendance and mother *regular*, only 3 percent of the children will subsequently become regulars themselves, while a further 59 percent will become irregulars. Over 38 percent will be lost.
- If the father is *non-practicing* and mother *regular*, only 2 percent of children will become regular worshippers, and 37 percent will attend irregularly. Over 60 percent of their children will be lost completely to the church!
