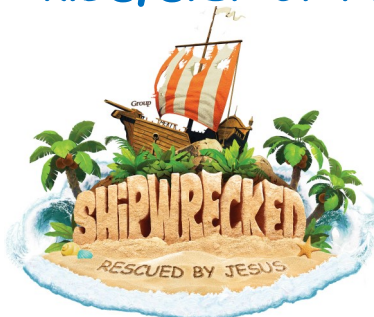


MINISTRY HIGHLIGHT

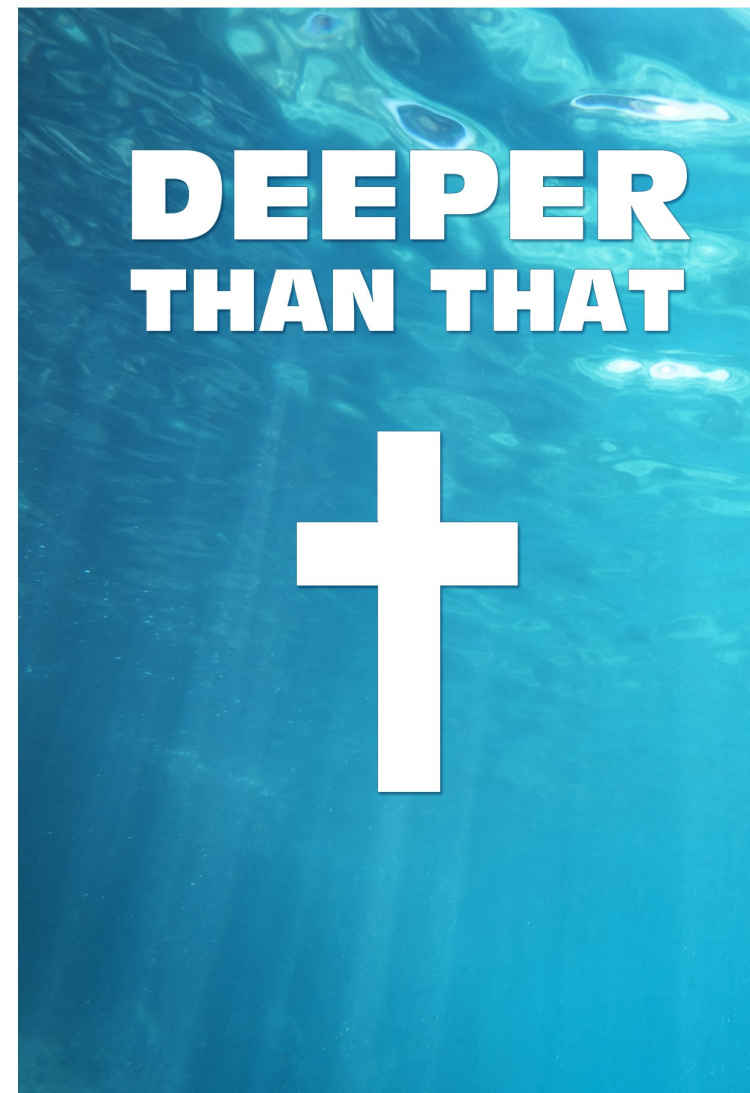
