NEW MEET/GREET OF PASTORAL CANDIDATE PROCESS

On Monday, we sent out information for the voting process timeline. At the time, we were working with the "50 people gathering" rule. As we were finishing this, the recommendation from the President of "10 people gathering together" came out.

After consulting with the District Superintendent, the candidate, the staff, and the board, we have established the following new process prior to the vote on March 29th.

Although we wish that it could be different, we all know that we are in unprecedented times. Our prayer is that you understand and will proceed with us in unity as we look for God's will for Grandview Nazarene Church.

New Process for Meet/Greet

1. The pastor and spouse will record a 15-30 minute video with testimony, devotional, or other thoughts for us to view.
2. We will then make that video available at the church for viewing during the week previous to the vote on March 29. *(Date and time will be set soon.)*
3. The viewing will have a maximum of 10 people per viewing.
4. The video will make clear of the need for confidentiality of this pastoral family.
5. The name of the family will be provided at that viewing.
6. You are encouraged to contact any of the church board members or Pastor Ron with questions that you might have.
7. We will also include a link to a sermon.
8. You will then have the opportunity to pray before voting.
